Beloved Broadway,

As we turn the calendar page again, I pray this summer afforded you a chance to relax, reconnect, and be renewed in your spirit. Working in churches these past 18 years, my life has never not revolved around the school calendar. September feels as much like the new year as January does. And, there is much to celebrate this new year.

The arrival of our new Associate Pastor for Children and Families marks the conclusion of over a year-long search and calling process.

Those processes rooted in the good, prayerful work long ago of our Staff, Search Committees, Deacons, and our Family Ministry Subcommittee have culminated in the unanimous calling of both Alissa Vance (part-time Minister to Youth) and Rev.
